Set Up Your Mobile Hotspot

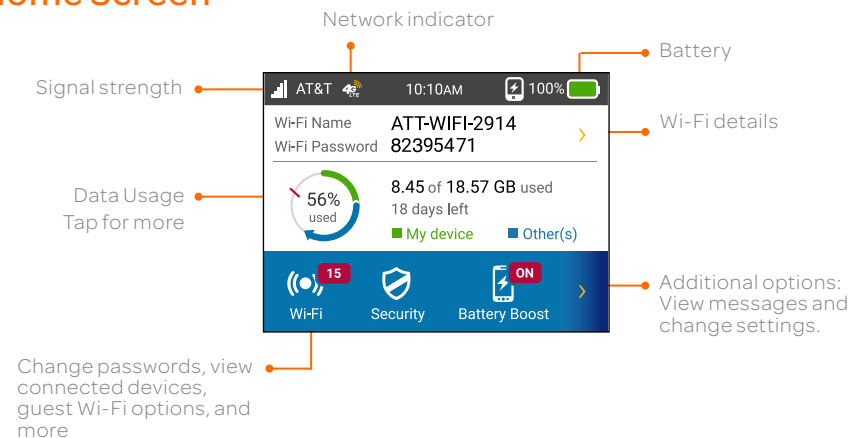
- ① Insert the battery.
- ② Install the back cover.
- ③ Firmly close the battery cover and accessory ports to ensure the device is water-resistant and dust proof.*



Note: The mobile hotspot comes with a pre-installed SIM card.

*Meets US MIL-STD-810G for shock-resistance. Certified IP65 for protection against dust and water jets. Device will not operate under water and should be dried as quickly as possible when wet. Shock-resistant when dropped from ≤ 4 ft onto flat surface. Device may not perform as shown in all extreme conditions.

Home Screen



Note: Check your Alerts and Messages for important service reminders.

Connect to the Internet

Turn on your Mobile Hotspot

- ① Press and release the power button.
- ② Tap the lock screen.
- ③ To navigate, tap the icons on the home screen.

Note: The screen goes dark to save power. Press and release the power button to wake the screen.

On your laptop or other wireless devices

- ① Open your Wi-Fi network connection manager.
- ② Connect your device to the hotspot with the Wi-Fi name and password.

Note: The home screen displays the hotspot's Wi-Fi network name and password. Your Wi-Fi network name will be different than this example.

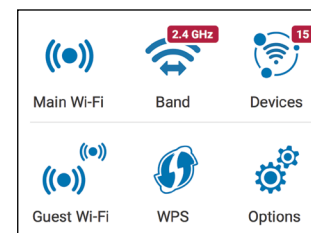


Basic Connection and Device Options

Change Wi-Fi settings



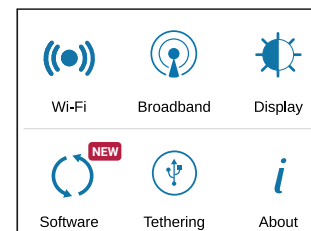
- Enable Guest Wi-Fi
- Change Main and Guest Wi-Fi names/passwords
- View connected devices
- Set maximum number of devices



Change basic device settings



- Adjust screen timeout.
- Adjust data connection settings
- Update software
- Find hotspot's wireless number
- Set Wi-Fi range
- Hide Wi-Fi network name and password.

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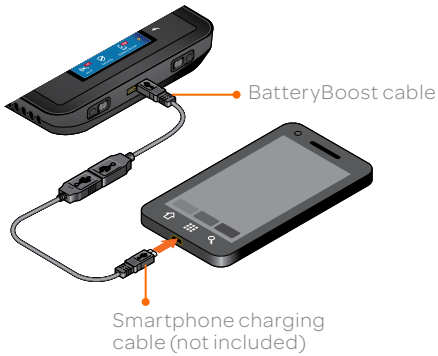
BatteryBoost

Use your mobile hotspot to charge your smartphone if its battery is low or out of power.

- ① Connect the BatteryBoost cable to the mobile hotspot's charging port.
- ② Connect your smartphone's charging cable to the BatteryBoost connector.


Note: To avoid depleting the hotspot's battery, the hotspot stops boosting when its battery reaches 10% or less.

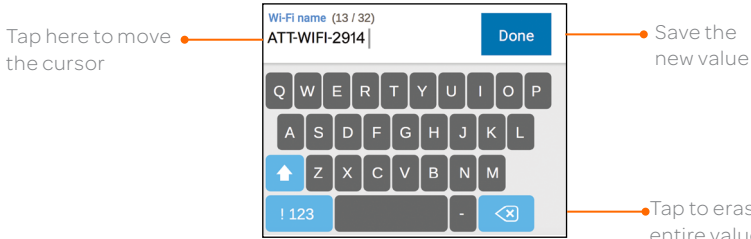
- To restart boosting, on the home screen, tap **BatteryBoost**.
- You can't charge the hotspot while its boosting your smartphone.



Wi-Fi Network Name and Password

Change Wi-Fi network name and password

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Main Wi-Fi**.
- ② Tap the **Pencil** (Edit) icon  beside the name or password to be changed.
- ③ Tap **OK**.



Hide password

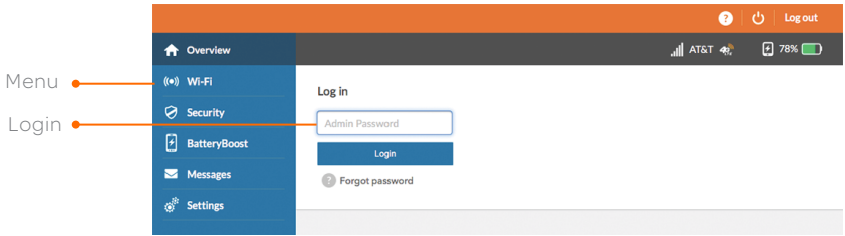
To hide the password:

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Main Wi-Fi**.
- ② Uncheck the **Display on home screen** box.

Advanced Settings – In Your Browser

Access device information and settings via the AT&T Wi-Fi Manager page from your connected device.

- ① Connect a Wi-Fi device to your mobile hotspot.
- ② Go to **http://attwifimanager/** in the connected device's browser.
- ③ The default login is **attadmin**.



Advanced Connection Options

Wi-Fi

For faster throughput on compatible devices, use 5 GHz Wi-Fi.

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Band**.
- ② Select **5 GHz**.



Guest Wi-Fi with Timer

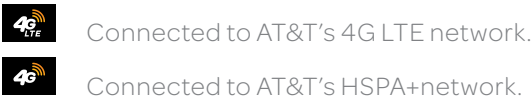
Share a connection using guest Wi-Fi and set how long it stays active:

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Guest Wi-Fi**.
- ② Tap **Guest Wi-Fi**. Guests can now choose the Guest Wi-Fi network in their connection manager.
- ③ Scroll down, select **Guest Timer**, and specify the settings (optional).



Network Indicators

Your 4G LTE wireless device will display one of the following network indicators to let you know which of AT&T's wireless networks you are connected to.

Block device access

To prevent a device from reconnecting to the mobile hotspot, add it to the hotspot's blocked list:

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Devices**.
- ② Select the device you want to block (there could be more than one page of connected devices).
- ③ Tap **Block Device**.



Unblock a device

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Devices > Blocked Device List**.
- ② Select the device you want to unblock, then tap **Unblock**.

Content Filtering/Parental Controls

Set up content filtering. Log in to **http://attwifimanager/** with your browser.

- ① On the home screen, tap **Security > Content Filters**.
- ② Select the level of content filtering.
