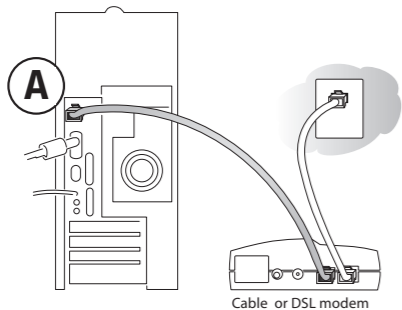
Installation Guide

Follow these quick steps to install your router.

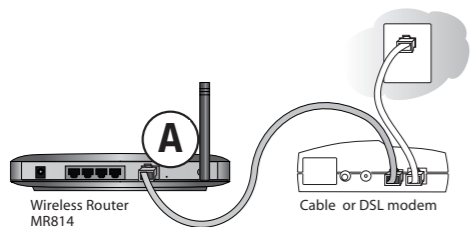
Before you begin, locate the broadband Internet configuration settings from your cable company. You can also consult the Install Assistant on the *GearBox™ CD for Wireless Router*.

1 Connect the Router

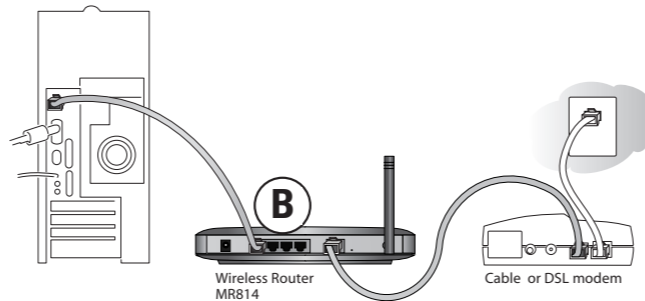
- Turn off your computer and cable or DSL modem.
- Disconnect the Ethernet cable from your computer (A) which connects to your cable or DSL modem.






- Connect the Ethernet cable from your cable or DSL modem to the Internet port (A) on the MR814.



- Connect the Ethernet cable which came with the router from a Local port on the router (B) to your computer.



- Turn on the cable or DSL modem and wait about 30 seconds for the lights to stop blinking.
- Now, turn on your computer. If software usually logs you in to your Internet connection, do not run that software or cancel it if it starts automatically.
- Verify the following:

-  When you turn the router on, the power light goes on.
-  The local lights are lit for any connected computers.
-  The Internet light is lit, indicating a link has been established to the cable or DSL modem.

Note: For wireless placement and range guidelines, and wireless configuration instructions, please see the *Reference Manual* on the *GearBox CD for Wireless Router*.

2 Log In to the Router

Note: To connect to the router, your computer needs to be configured to obtain an IP address automatically via DHCP. For instructions on how to do this, please see Appendix C in the *Reference Manual* on the *GearBox CD for Wireless Router*.

- Connect to the router by typing `http://192.168.0.1` in the address field of Internet Explorer or Netscape® Navigator.



- For security reasons, the router has its own user name and password. When prompted, enter **admin** for the router user name and **password** for the router password, both in lower case letters.

Note: The user name and password are not the same as any user name or password you may use to log in to the Internet.

Prior to returning any defective product, the end customer or the reseller from whom the end customer originally purchased the product must obtain a Return Materials Authorization (RMA) number from NETGEAR. All defective products should be returned to NETGEAR with shipping charges prepaid. NETGEAR will not accept collect shipments.

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
